## Overview

Cisco announces a change in product part numbers for the Cisco Subscription HCS for Contact Center. This is a product part number change only announcement. Customers will experience no change in functionality when using the new product part numbers. The new product part numbers are designed to simplify the customer ordering process. The last day to order the affected product using the current product part numbers is January 3, 2020. Customers will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) until otherwise specified in the end-of-life announcement for the new product part numbers. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement.

Subscription HCS for Contact Center is now offered through the Flex Contact Center part numbers. Exact functionality is available with the Premium flex part numbers, A-FLEX-HJEPC for ICM based HCS for Contact Center agents, and A-FLEX-HJXPC FOR UCCX based HCS for Contact Center Agents. Please note that Subscription HCS for Contact Center and Hosted Flex Contact Center part numbers are only available for authorized HCS for Contact Center partners. For ordering information on Flex contact center, please see the Cisco Collaboration Flex Plan Contact Center ordering guide.

End-of-Life Announcement Date	The date the document that announces the end of sale and end of life of a product is distributed to the general public.	October 4, 2019
End-of-Sale Date: App SW	The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date.	January 3, 2020
Last Ship Date: App SW	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	April 2, 2020
