This article describes how to collect the System Event log bundle from a Cisco C880 M4 server.

Steps

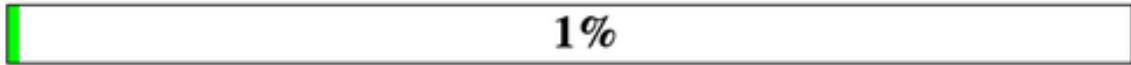
- 1) Connect to the C880 M4 MMB browser graphical user interface (GUI).
- 2) Click on **System Event Log** on the left menu and then click on **Download**.
