Introduction

Setting up access rules allow for granular control of the types of traffic passing through your network. Access rules are a good method to enact company policy as well as security policy. This article will focus on the why and how of managing the day and time schedules for the application of access control rules.

Why manage the day and time of access rules?

Day and time application of access control list (ACL) allows flexible application of organization policy. Example use cases include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Your office is only open during weekdays/weekends
- 2. Preventing wireless access to neighbors in off hours
- 3. Enabling off hour access for a given port or device
