

How to Enable the Discovery-Bonjour Settings on RV016, RV042, RV042G and RV082 VPN Routers

Objective

Bonjour is a service discovery protocol that locates network devices such as printers and servers on the LAN. When this feature is enabled, the router periodically multicasts Bonjour service records to the entire local network to advertise its existence.

This article explains how to enable Discovery-Bonjour on RV016, RV042, RV042G, and RV082 VPN Routers

Enable Discovery-Bonjour

Step 1. Log in to the web configuration utility and choose **System Management > Discovery-Bonjour**. The *Discovery-Bonjour* page opens:
