About the Cisco 5400 Enterprise Network Compute System

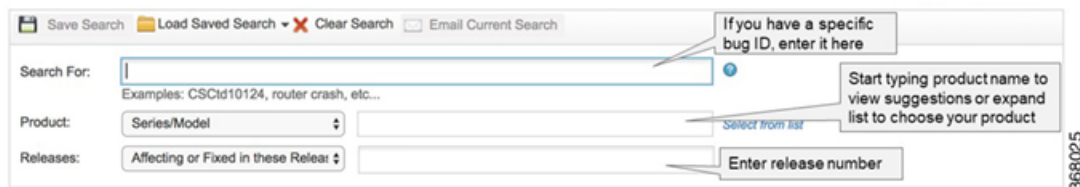

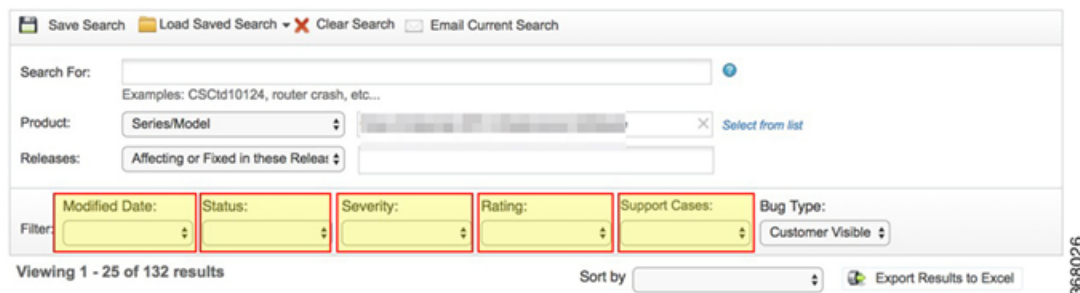
About the Cisco Bug Search Tool
